Arrangements for Year 11 after half term

As per Mrs Hogg's previous letter to you, I am writing to confirm the arrangements for Year 11 after half term. On Monday-Thursday, students will be able to complete self-guided work via Microsoft Teams whilst studying independently at home. They will need to access the Year 11 'Team' and the use 'assignments' tab to select sessions and activities to follow each day.

We have arranged the resources into six key areas, and you can find out more about these aspects of study on the attached roadmap:

- Change makers – coping with change
- Build up – developing the 'soft skills' which are important for further study and the workplace
- English and maths boosters – functional, real-world skills of English and maths
- Subject tasters – a range of A Levels and vocational course subject tasters
- LORIC – developing the skills of leadership, organisation, resilience, initiative and communication
- Money matters – an introduction to finances and money management

Students can 'mix and match' the resources they access and complete based on their own skills and areas of development. We will be able to monitor which activities students have opened and completed, and students should feel free to message me, Ms Cross or their personalised learning tutors on Teams with any queries or questions. The resources will be live and available for use from the morning of Monday 7th June.

We are looking forward to seeing Year 11 in person each Friday up to and including the 25th June in order to complete some hugely important work around careers, futures and PSHE.
